

Bike Share Demo Program

Looking for a fun, convenient and low-cost way for visiting students to experience Boulder by bike? What better way than getting them on B-cycles? With 280 bikes at 40 stations around town, Boulder's nonprofit bike share system is the perfect solution to your transportation needs.

Best of all, our demo program makes checking out bikes a breeze.

How it works:

- We'll give you one demo card per visiting student to use Boulder B-cycle for a 24-hour period (up to 10 cards)—no credit card required
- Each demo card allows access to one B-cycle at a time from any station.
- Riders can take an unlimited number of 30 minute trips during their 24-hour access period, from any station to any other.
- Usage fees apply to all trips over 30 minutes—this is sharing, after all!
- Upon completion of the demo period, Boulder B-cycle will invoice your department for the passes and any usage fees incurred.

What it costs:

Entry Pass		Cost Per Trip	
24 hours		0-30 minutes	Each additional 30 minutes
\$8	PLUS	\$0	PLUS \$3
Return bike and repeat to start a new trip.
